SCN Theatre Prepares Winter Comedy:
THE SKIN OF OUR TEETH
By Thornton Wilder

SCN Theatre will present the 1943 Pulitzer Prize winning play The Skin of Our Teeth, by Thornton Wilder, on Thursday, February 2, through Saturday, February 4, at 7:30 p.m. The play will take place in the SCN Auditorium.

Thornton Wilder was known to attack some established theatrical conventions but in this production, he commits every anti-conventional choice he can from major cast members breaking character (“I don’t understand a word of this play!”), the absurdity of talking pets, to a family that has lived for over 5,000 years. The production focuses on a nuclear family - the Antrobuses - and their maid, who have escaped from one end of the world disaster after another, from the Ice Age, to the illustrious flood, and finally through war, and only by “the skin of their teeth.” Overall, the play combines farce, satire, mythical and historical allusions, and even symbolism all to emphasize Wilder’s commentary about human endurance.

With a combined cast and crew, there are over 35 students involved in this production to create the most humorously absurd and unforgettable theatrical experience at North! It will definitely be a play you won’t want to miss, even by the skin of your teeth.
