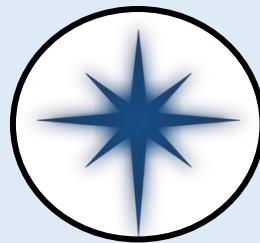

STC PUBLIC LIBRARY TO OFFER COLLEGE PLANNING AND FINANCIAL WORKSHOPS

The St. Charles Public Library is offering two free college workshops for high school students and parents in the month of November. These workshops will provide information on the college search and financial preparation for students and parents who attend.

Making Your College Search Count is scheduled for Wednesday, November 1, at 7:00 p.m. in the Carnegie Community Room. Julie Nelson, Regional Recruitment Director for Xavier University, will cover the college admissions process, including campus visits, application tips, and financial assistance, and finding the right school.

FAFSA Step-by-Step is scheduled for Thursday, November 16, at 7:00 p.m. in the Carnegie Community Room. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the form used to apply for most federal and state and many institutional financial aid programs, including the Federal Pell Grant and the Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP). This presentation will provide a step-by-step review of the FAFSA that includes: what information is required to complete the form; student eligibility and dependency questions; and how to avoid common mistakes in completing the form.
