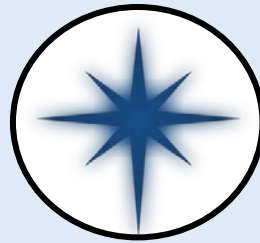

The St. Charles Public Library is offering a free college workshop for high school students and parents. The workshop will provide information on financial preparation for students and parents who attend.



FAFSA Step-by-Step is scheduled for Thursday, November 16, at 7:00 p.m. in the Carnegie Community Room. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the form used to apply for most federal and state and many institutional financial aid programs, including the Federal Pell Grant and the Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP). This presentation will provide a step-by-step review of the FAFSA that includes: what information is required to complete the form; student eligibility and dependency questions; and how to avoid common mistakes in completing the form.
